Glossary of Acronyms:

KIA – An individual who was killed in action, whether at the front or by enemy action in the rear areas, or if a prisoner of war, whether by air bombardment of his prison camp or by being shot while escaping, is designated “KIA” – killed in action.

DOW – Persons who were wounded and later died are marked “DOW” – died of wounds.

DOI – Those suffered fatal injuries as opposed to wounds, in combat or in combat areas, and died in a line-of-duty status, are designated “DOI” – died of injuries.

DNB – Other line-of-duty deaths, such as from sickness, homicide, suicide or accidents outside combat areas (including training and maneuver deaths) are listed “DNB”—died non-battle.
