## **Museum Fact Sheet**

### **Description**

The History Museum of Mobile at Old City Hall has approximately 20,000 square feet of exhibit space, a collection of more than 100,000 artifacts, a research library with a collection of some 5,000 books, a classroom, an auditorium, a fabrication shop, a collection storage area, a loading dock, design studios, meeting rooms, and offices for the staff.

Current activities of the museum include: guided tours, special educational events and programs, outreach activities for local schools, teacher workshops and open houses, a changing exhibit schedule that presents both traveling and in house exhibits, conservation and preservation workshops, book signings, lectures, and presentations by the staff to schools and local civic groups.

### **Location**

The History Museum of Mobile is conveniently located in historic downtown Mobile at 111 South Royal Street. The Museum is within walking distance from the Mobile Convention Center, the Riverview Hotel, a variety of restaurants and the Site of Historic Fort Condé. Traveling on I-10 East or I-10 West, exit Water Street/Downtown, Exit 26B. Turn left at the first traffic light onto Government Street. Turn left at the next traffic light onto S. Royal Street. The History Museum of Mobile is on the left.
